



Did you know? John Wesley...

1. Was born June 17, 1703 in Epworth, England.
2. Was the 15th of 19 children.
3. Woke up at 4 am to begin preaching at 5 am practically every day of his ministry.
4. Rode 4,500 miles per year, by horse, to carry the Gospel.
5. Preached up to 4 times a day.
