

Supernatural Cloud

Acrylic Finger Painting



Supplies:

Note: The number listed after each linked supply shows how many projects you can make from each item.

- Acrylic paint - 12 projects
- 1 tsp. [Pale blue](#)
- 1 tsp. [French blue](#)
- 1 tsp. [Dark blue](#)
- 1 tsp. [Sage green](#)
- 1 tsp. [White](#)
- 1 tsp. [Brown](#)
- 1 tsp. [Golden brown](#)
- 1 Tbs. [White puffy paint](#) - 8 projects
- 1 [4x6 Sheet of acrylic](#) - 10 projects
- Printable Cloud stencil, cut out
- Scotch or painter's tape
- Scissors

Tips:

- Mix white with the paints to get lighter shades.
- Use a thin layer of paint when finger painting.
- Dab the puffy paint on for a fluffier look, avoid spreading it too thin.
- The color that touches the acrylic first is what is seen from the front. Dip your finger in several colors at once to get the swirled look.

For a class setting:

- Cut out Cloud templates for each student.
- Pre-measure paint for each student.

Instructions:

1. Finger paint the bottom third of the acrylic. Dab brown and green paint letting the colors mix onto the acrylic. Let dry.



2. On the top two-thirds of the acrylic, dab different shades of blue and white letting the colors mix. Let dry.



3. On the unpainted side of the acrylic, use two rolled pieces of tape to hold your Cloud stencil in place. (We don't recommend double-sided tape as it will be difficult to remove.)



4. Trace the Cloud stencil with puffy paint onto the unpainted side of the acrylic. Remove the stencil. Fill in the Cloud shape with puffy paint. Let dry.
