Intro and Class Summary

1. Gather Students And Begin In Prayer.

2. Class Summary:

In this craftclass we had the girls decorate their sewing binders to make it uniquely their own. We supplied them with various media, such as scrapbook paper, fabric scraps, needle, thread, glitter, ribbon, stickers, paint, twine, markers. This binder will be a good place for them to save all their sewing papers, practice stitches, notes, and quotes.

3. Theme (Creativity):

Embellishing is a creative way to add to and improve a project, making it uniquely yours. It can be fun to decorate using fabric paints, embroidery, appliques, or even sew-on buttons.
