

SEVEN SEALS

Scroll

TUTORIAL



SUPPLIES:

- SCISSORS
- PARCHMENT PAPER
- CARDSTOCK (IF MAKING PAPER SEALS)
- GOLDEN STRING 12"
-7 PIECES
- GLUE DOTS- 14
- VINTAGE PAPER
-4 SHEETS
- HOT GLUE GUN
- RED SEAL WAX
- SEAL STAMP



NOTE:

If you are unable to find a seal press, you can cut out the printable version for paper Seals.

FOR A CLASS SETTING:

We recommend prepping steps 2 & 3 before class. For younger classes, we recommend cutting out Scroll pages 2-6 and prepping step 5 as well.



1

Print Scroll pages onto vintage paper, and cut out.

2

Cut 7 pieces of gold string, each one about 12" in length.

With your sealing wax and stamp ready, use your hot glue gun to squirt a small amount of wax (a little smaller than the size of your stamp) onto parchment paper. Let it set for about 10 seconds, then gently press your stamp into the wax. Let it cool for about 30 seconds, and carefully peel the Seal away from the stamp. (Alternatively, cut out the paper Seals printable.)



4

Cut seals 1-6 in half. Leave the 7th Seal whole.

(Refer to tutorial video)
Place end of string on top of glue dot while still on its transfer paper. Place another glue dot on top of string, so the string will be in between two glue dots. Peel off top transfer paper and firmly press Seal to the glue dot. Repeat for remaining Seals. (Make sure your string is on the right side of the Seal.)

Carefully remove transfer paper from back of Seal and attach Seal on the top corner of each coordinating Scroll. Press firmly to secure.

7

Starting with the 7th Seal, roll the Scroll and wrap the string around Scroll, then around the Seal to secure.



8

Roll the 6th Seal around the bottom of the 7th Seal and repeat process. Repeat this for all of the Seals.
