CLASS NAME: Samuel Listened

LESSON:

- Brother Branham begins our lesson by reading the Scripture as the students follow along in their Bibles.
- Teacher rehearses/summarizes what was read with the students while using the flannel graph (pages 6-7) and some drama!
- Transition: "Brother Branham heard the Voice of God too, and tells us about it in a quote I have for you today. Did you know that you can hear the Voice of God too, anytime you want! All you have to do is push_____! (Student fills in the blank "play"). And you will get to hear the very same Voice! We can hear HIM in our quiet time too, if we get quiet enough and pray and wait to hear HIM. He will speak to you maybe in your heart, or maybe a peace that comes over you; could be in the Word you read or even when you push_____! (play)"
- Play quote using listening ears (page 6) to hold up when the student hears key words: "hear Him," "speaking," "speak," and "The Voice of God."
- Is the same God who spoke to Samuel on his bed the same God who spoke to Brother Branham? Yes!
- Who knows Hebrews 13:8? Class recites this verse together.
- Yes, He is the same even today! Samuel was a hero in his day because he listened to the Voice of God and had to take a stand. It wasn't easy for him. Samuel Listened!
- You are a hero in your day just like Samuel, did you know that? Samuel listened to God's Voice and he had to take a stand. You listen to the Voice of God too and you are taking a stand for God, and it won't always be easy!
- When do you listen to the Voice of God? Every time you push play you hear His Voice. When you do your quiet time, read your Bible and pray you can listen for Him to speak back to you! It's the same Voice of God that spoke to the prophet Samuel and to Brother Branham.
- You take a stand too; when you sisters dress like a Christian ought to; when you live a holy life; when you tell others about Jesus or Brother Branham!
- Show "Samuel" issue 21 of Cub Corner and encourage students to complete the "Hear His Voice" quiz enclosed.

Scripture Quote:

“Now, I have chosen for a text this morning. And you little fellows forgive me for taking the time all with the adults, and your class is not here to be this morning. But I want you to hear also what I want to read.

And I want to read this morning out of I Samuel the 3rd chapter. And I want to take for a text: “Hear His Voice.” That will do for little girls, and big girls, and little boys, and big boys, all. Remember the text: “Hear His Voice.”

Now, to you that’s turning in the Scriptures to I Samuel the 3rd chapter. This is how it reads for the first ten verses.

1 And the child Samuel ministered unto the LORD before Eli. And the word of the LORD was precious in those days; there was no open vision.

Oh, how I would like to dwell there for a minute. Maybe some other time... It just strikes me. Let me just read it once again, that verse.

And the child Samuel ministered unto the LORD before Eli. And the word of the LORD was precious in those days; for there was no open vision.

See what a vision is then? It’s the direct Word of the LORD. And the LORD’s Word was precious.

2 And it came to pass at that time, when Eli was laid down in his place, and his eyes begin to wax dim, that he could not see.

3 And ere the lamp of God went out in the temple of the LORD, where the ark of God was, and Samuel was laid down to sleep;

4 That the LORD called Samuel: and he answered, Here am I.

5 And he ran to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou callest me. And he said, I called not; lie down again. And he went and laid down.

6 And the LORD--And the LORD called yet again, Samuel. And Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, Here I... Here am I; for thou didst call me. And he answered, I called not, my son; lie down again.

7 Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, neither was the word of the LORD yet revealed unto him.

8 And the LORD called Samuel again the third time. And he arose and went to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou didst call me. And Eli perceived that the LORD had called the child.

9 Therefore Eli said unto Samuel, Go, lie down: and it shall be, if he call thee, that thou shall say, Speak, LORD; for thy servant heareth. So Samuel went and laid down in his place.

10 And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. And Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth.”

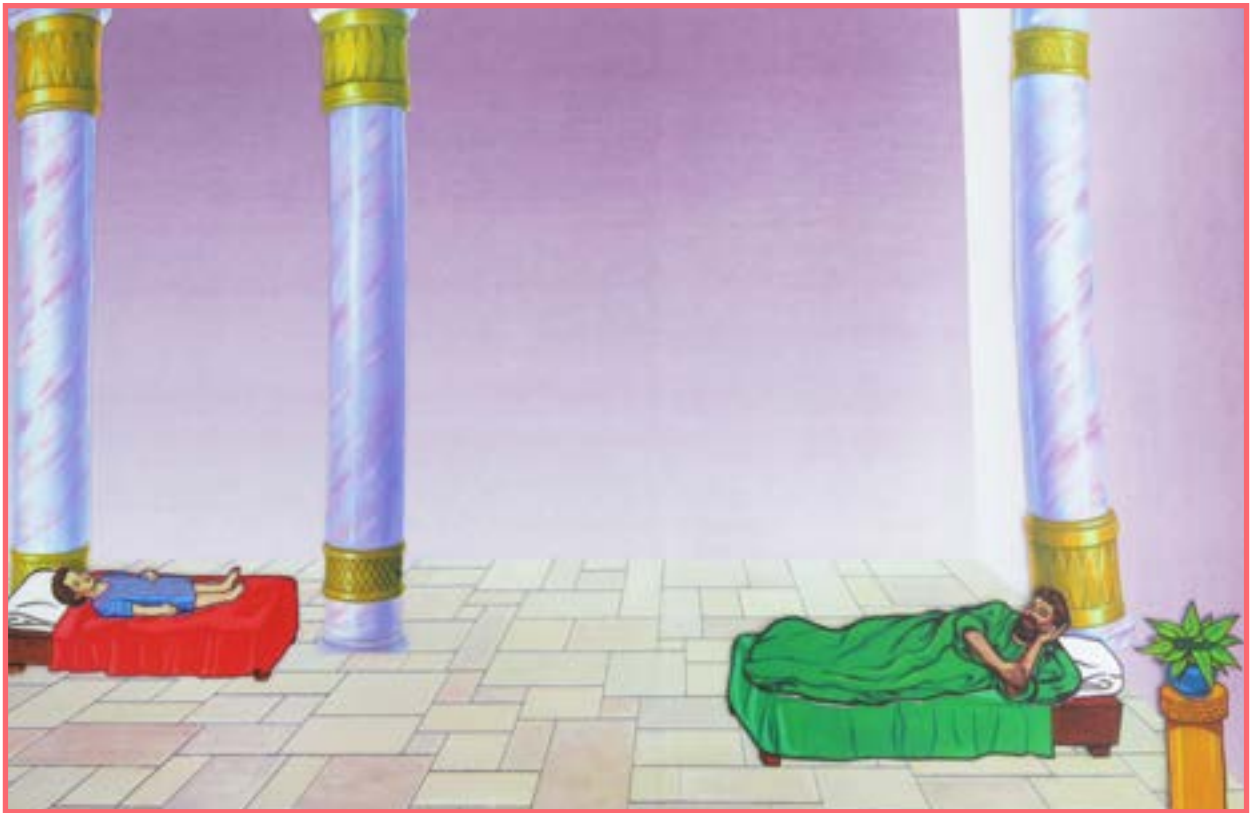

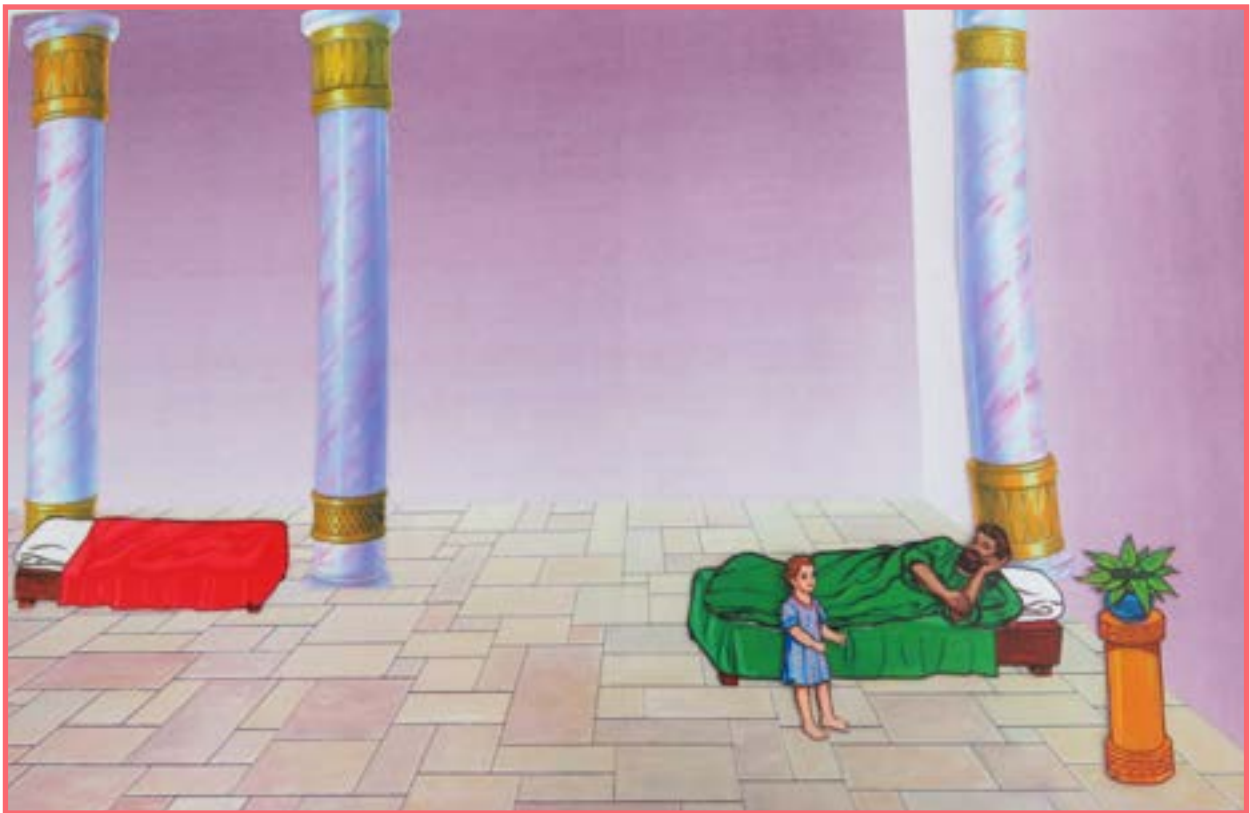

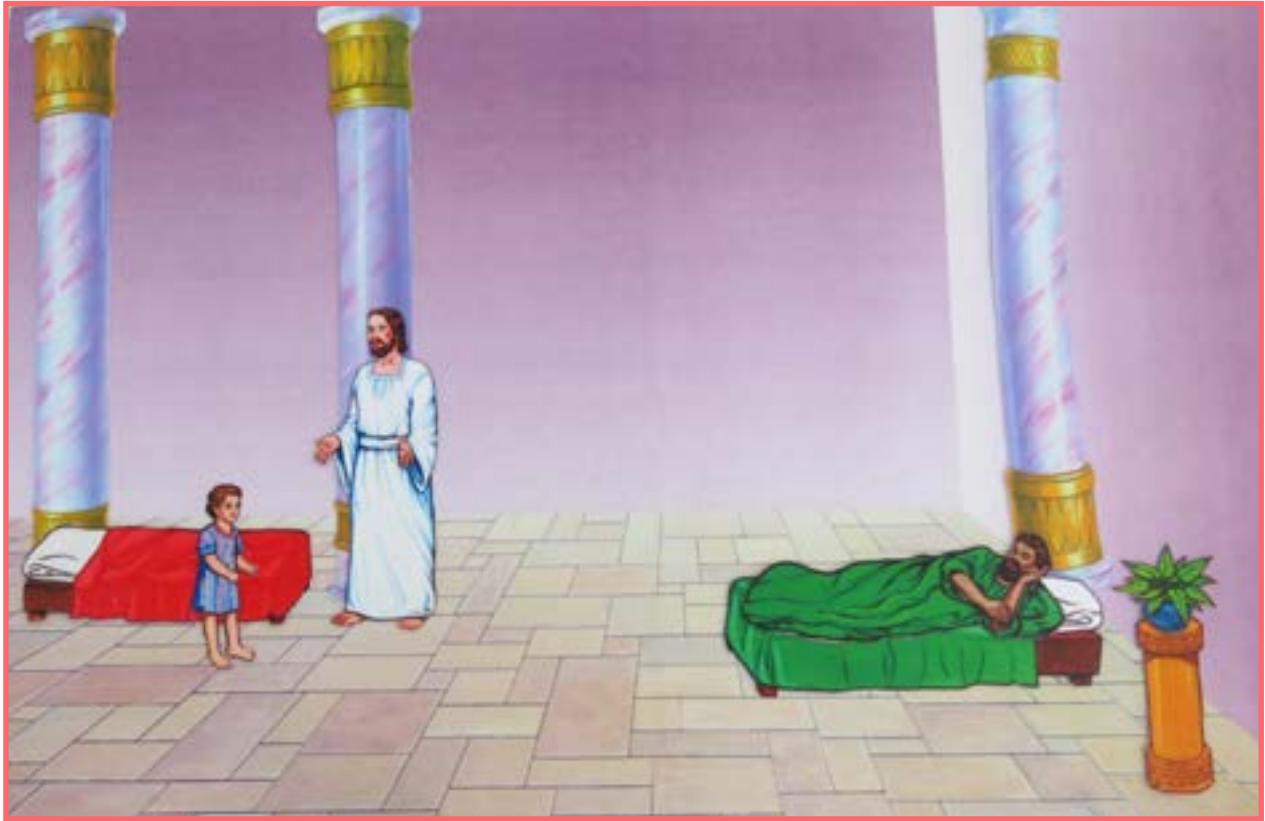

lengths.



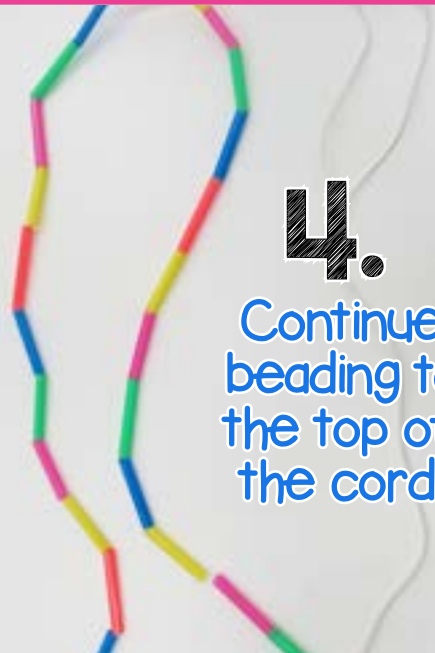
3.
