



SUPPLIES:

- Printable Templates
- 2 4oz. packs Model Magic Air Dry Clay

 - [option 2](#) - for 4 projects
- Acrylic Paint Color Ratio - Mix 1 tsp. White paint with each of the following colors. (you will have a little extra paint)
 - 1 tsp. Pink
 - 3/4 tsp. Red + 1/4 tsp. Brown
 - 1 tsp. Orange
 - 1 tsp. Yellow
 - 1 tsp. Green
 - 1 tsp. Mint
 - 1/4 tsp. Indigo
 - 1 tsp. Violet
- [Wood Kabob Sticks](#)
- Rolling Pin
- Clay Tools
- Scissors
- Tape
- Paintbrushes
- Paint Palette or [Ramekins](#)

PROJECT TIME:

1 hour 20 minutes

FOR A CLASS SETTING:

- Measure out paint needed for each project
- Pre-mix paint colors
- Cut out paper templates

NOTES:

- This can be attached to any solid surface, such as a picture frame, easel, wooden plaque, etc.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Cut out pyramid templates. Tape 2 pieces of the large pyramid together to make one piece.
- Roll out clay to 1/4" thick and lay large pyramid template over clay. Cut out pyramid with clay tools.
- Place the smaller template over the pyramid, and use kabob stick to press into the clay to make lines around the edge of the pyramid.
- Using the template as a guide, press the kabob stick into clay to create a line for each layer.
- Using your clay tool, cut out the rectangle just below the triangle at the top.
- Mix paint ratios listed in supplies. Paint each layer, starting with pink on the bottom. Continue painting each layer the colors of the rainbow. Paint the triangle at the top violet.
- Allow clay to dry a few hours or overnight.
