

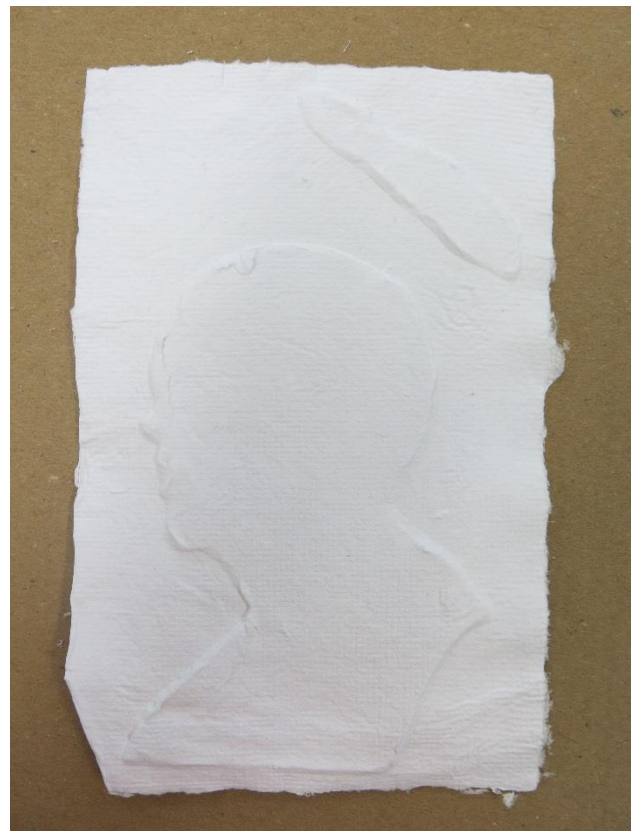

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AT CREATIONS CLASS

As the sisters entered the room they were already curious and anxious to get started seeing the three paper making stations set up. After dedicating the class time to our Lord Jesus in prayer we quickly got into the lesson for the day.

As a class, the girls knowingly drew comparisons between the paper making and the Christian's walk. They were split into two groups and given a tray of straw which had a dirty jar laying in it, as well, as a quote:

"The first thing, there's a glass laying out in the hog pen, chicken yard, whatever it is. You want to use it. The first thing, you pick it up. That's justification. You've got it in your hand. You can't use it yet; it needs to be cleansed. Then you take it in; you wash it, sterilize it, boil it, and takes all the germs and the--out of it. That's what God does through sanctification: takes all the desire of sin out of your heart, cleans you up. And then you are a candidate for the filling of the Holy Spirit. See? Then the word "sanctify" means "to be cleansed and set aside for service." That's the Old Testament: the altar sanctified the vessels. And cleansed and set aside for service is not "in service." It's "set aside for service." And when it's "in service," "Blessed are they that hunger and thirst after righteousness for they shall be filled." The Holy Spirit comes in and fills up that vessel till running over, bubbling over, and then you're "in" the service of the Lord."

- Cleaning the dirty glass

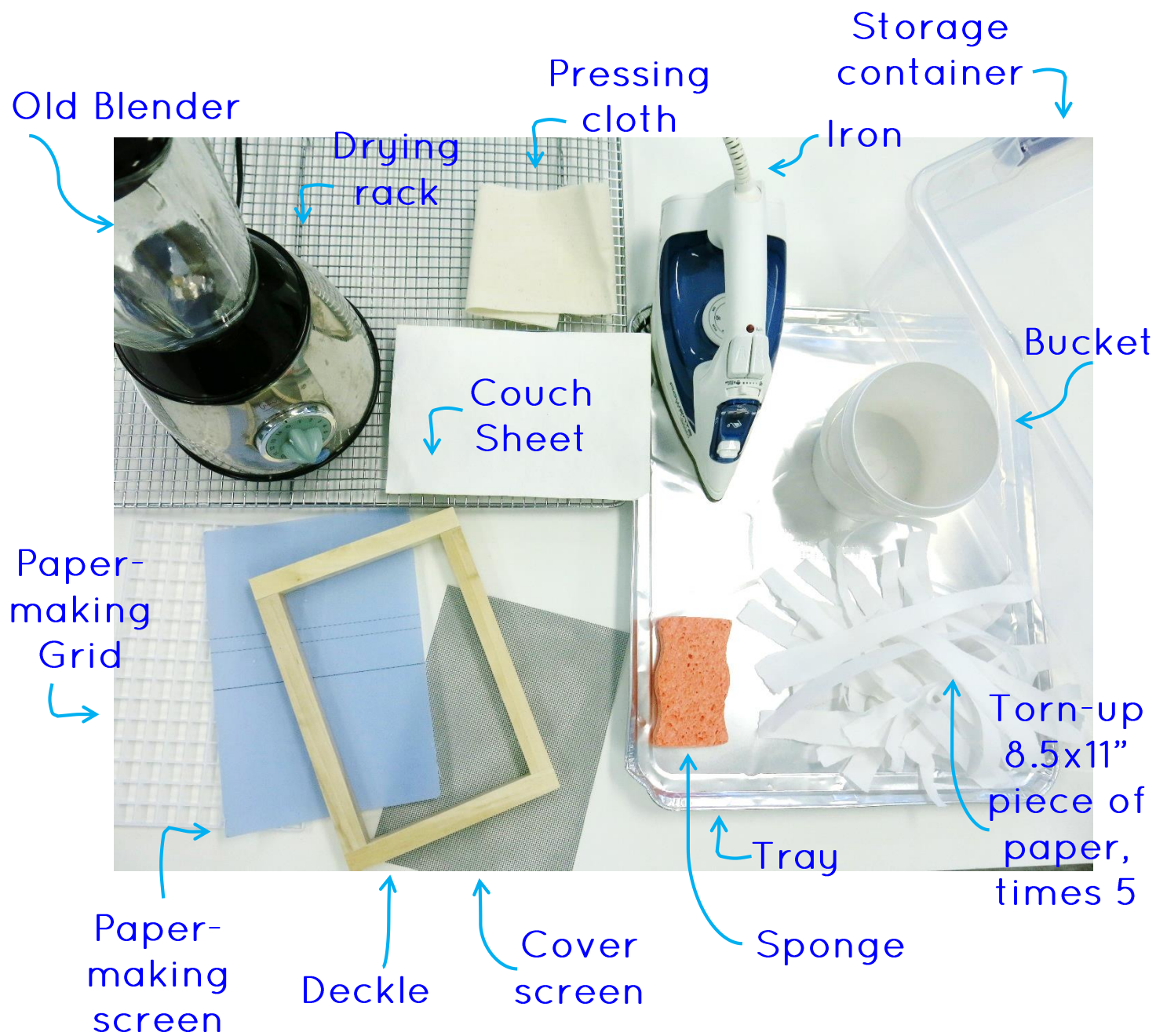
3. Baptism of the Holy Spirit

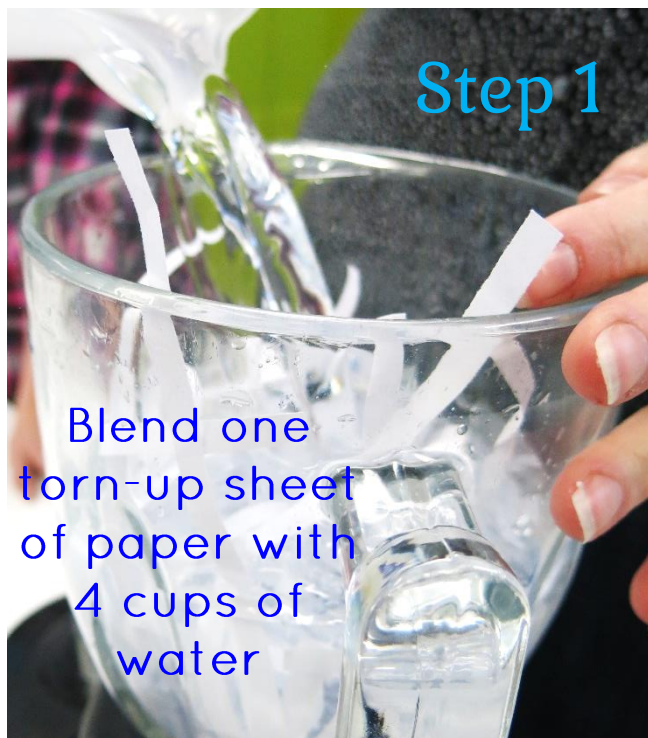
- New Birth

Paper-Making





Step 5

Mix the pulp

Step 6

Scoop the handmold into the pulp vertically and come up completely flat, smooth, and evenly

Step 7

Scoop the pulp off the frame and there should be a thin, even layer of pulp

Step 8

Place the hand mold on the tray

Take off the deckle and put the cover screen on top then pull the grid from under the papermaking screen

Step 9

Step 10

Press the sponge on the cover screen to soak up the water, repeat and squeeze out the water in your bucket

Remove the cover screen and place a Couch sheet on top of the created paper

Step 11

Step 12

Flip the layers over and remove the papermaking screen

Step 13

Place another Couch sheet on top of the created paper and press with your hands

Step 14

Place the layers on the rack and remove the top Couch sheet to dry

Turn the iron to low heat with no steam, place a pressing cloth on top of your created paper, and iron

Step 15

You're finished!

Profile Embossing on Created Paper

Prep work: take a profile picture of yourself and print in a 5x7

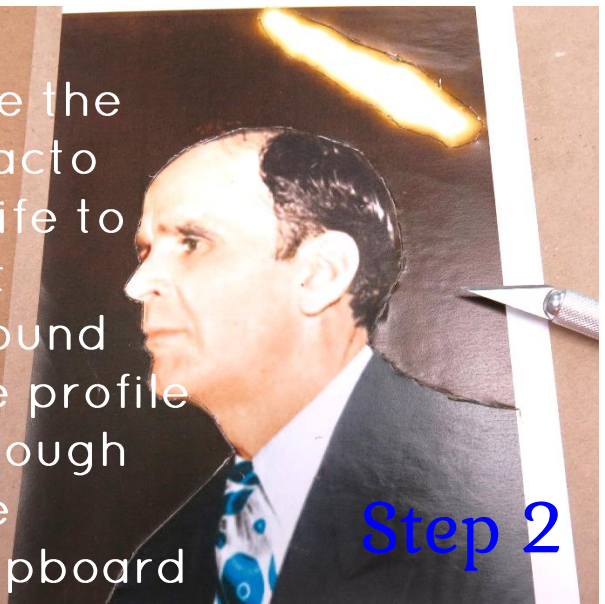


Glue the profile onto the
chipboard



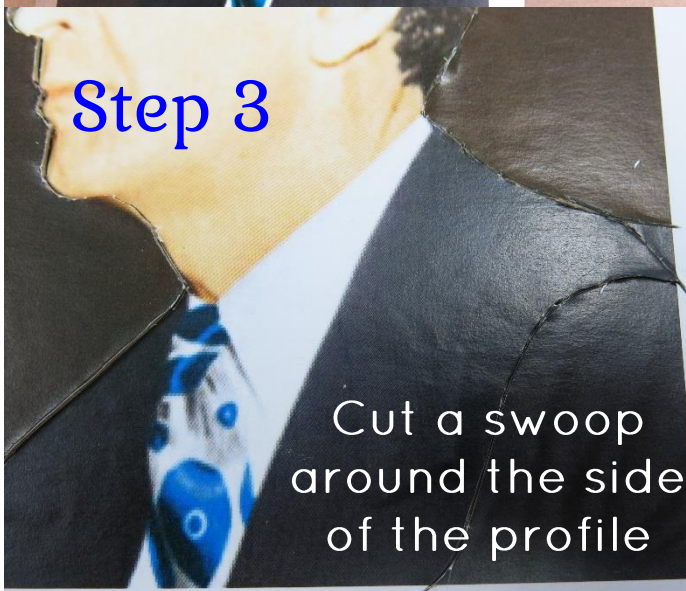
Step 1

Cut a swoop
around the side
of the profile

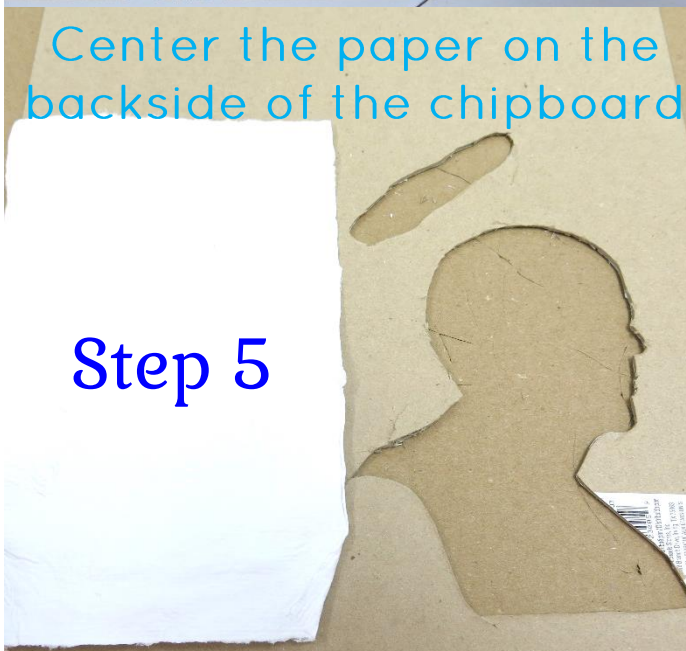
Step 4

out of

chipboard

Center the paper on the
backside of the chipboard

Step 6

Tape the paper down



Step 7



Hold the board with the paper up to a window and turn out the lights so that you can see the profile shadow

Step 8



Use the end of a marker to LIGHTLY press around the edges of the profile to emboss

Step 9

Take the paper off the chipboard and flip over
