
## Beads

## Supplies Needed:

- 1. Printable pattern sheets
- 2. Double-sided tape
- 3. Perler bead tweezers (optional)
- 4. Perler beads variety of colors
- 5. Perler bead pegboard
- 6. Ironing paper (parchment paper)
- 7. Household iron and ironing board


(heat-safe surface)

Tip: For your first one do a test sample. Each iron will vary in heat. Some irons will need medium to high heat to fuze the beads.




step 1

Print and cut out pattern sheet.



## step 2

Place the pattern sheet below the Perler bead pegboard with double-sided tape image facing up if you have a transparent pegboard. If not, follow the pattern sheet the best you can.



## step 3

Once you complete the pattern, place the pegboard on flat heat-safe surface.

Turn your iron onto medium heat. Do not use steam setting. Remove water from iron.



step 4


Once iron reaches medium temperature, place ironing paper over pegboard. In a circular motion begin to iron project. Let cool. Beads need heat for about 10-20 seconds per side to fuse evenly.


Additional heating time may be needed.



step 5

Once cooled, remove paper and beaded design from pegboard. Flip design over to expose the non-fused side. Repeat step 4. Place on a hard, flat surface and place a book on top of it to keep your design flat while cooling.






Pillar Of Fire number of beads




Mountain number of beads


Cloud number of beads


