





Altitude is the height of an object above earth or above sea level. Objects that fly or are suspended in the atmosphere are usually measured by altitude, which is commonly referred to in measurements of feet (12 inches).

**Elevation** is the height to which a certain place rises above sea level, which includes objects such as mountains, landmarks, and the tops of buildings and other structures. Elevation is also typically measured in feet (12 inches).

Both use an altimeter that measures the distance of a point above sea level.

This map shows the elevations of the continental United States. You can see where the mountains and higher elevations start and end. On this particular map, the lowest elevation is 282 feet below sea level, and the highest elevation is 14,494 feet above sea level. As you look at this particular map, Indiana is fairly flat compared to the other highlight states. The three main mountain ranges in the United States are the Appalachian Mountains in the East, the Rocky Mountains in the West (going through Montana)

and Colorado) and the Sierra Nevada mountains in California
