SUPPLIES NEEDED:

1. Cloud stencil- PDF
 2. Scissors
 3. Pencil
 4. Masking tape
 5. Wooden plaque
large version: 9"x10", $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick
small version: 6"x6", $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick
 6. Nails:
large version: 62 1" stainless steel nails
small version: 39 1" stainless steel nails
 7. Hammer
 8. Yarn: white and light blue
- String Art Tip: We recommend that you pre-hammer the nails on your string art before Easter Weekend as it can be loud.

STEP 1

Print the Cloud and the Pillar of Fire stencils. Trim as needed. Before you start the project, you can paint your wood plaque or leave it raw wood. If you choose to paint, let the paint dry before continuing to the next steps.



STEP 2

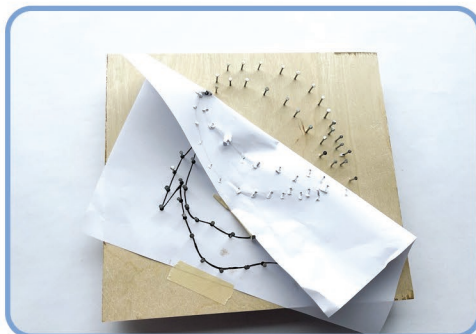
Lay stencil on plaque, and tape the sides.
Tip: Turn the Cloud to the right before taping.

STEP 3

Carefully hammer the nails into stencil on the pre-marked dots on the stencil. Starting with the inner nails first, work your way to the outer. Only hammer about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch to save room to wrap your yarn around the nail.



STEP 4

Remove the paper.



STEP 5

Start with the white yarn and tie it to one of the nails. Trim excess yarn if needed. Weave the white yarn between the nails and go all the way around the Cloud. You can do multiple layers and weave through the nails in a zigzag pattern. Do not weave through the center of the Cloud. Tie off the end and trim excess yarn once completed.



STEP 6

Last, use a lighter blue and weave a few layers around the outer nails. Tie off the end and trim excess yarn once completed.

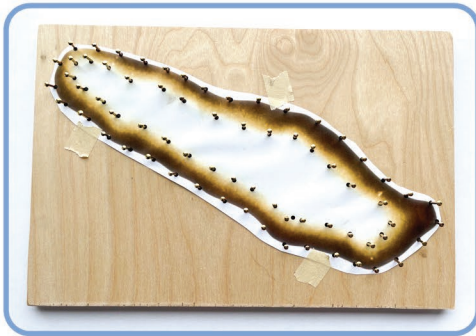

String art continued:

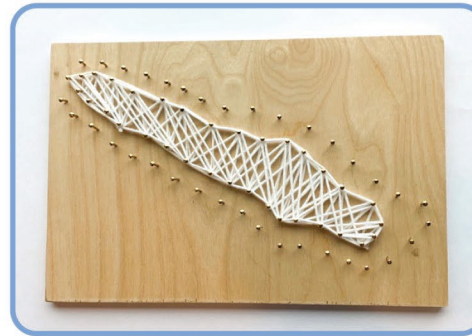
SUPPLIES NEEDED:

1. Pillar of Fire stencil- PDF
2. Scissors
3. Pencil
4. Masking tape
5. Wooden plaque
large version: 8"x12", $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick
small version: 5"x7", $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick
6. Nails:
large version: 58- 1" gold wire nails
small version: 39- 1" gold wire nails
7. Hammer
8. Yarn: white, golden yellow, light yellow



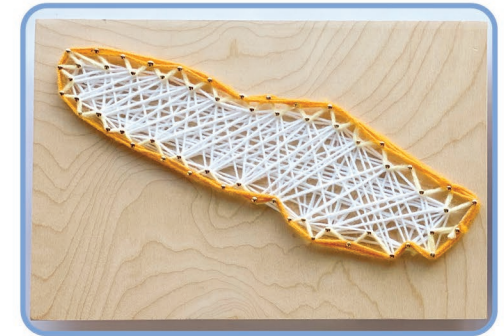
PILLAR OF FIRE

Follow steps 1-4 from the Cloud.
Make sure the Pillar of Fire is facing
the right direction.



STEP 5

Next use a lighter yellow yarn and tie it off on
one of the nails. Trim away any excess yarn.
Weave the lighter yellow between the nails. Do not
weave in the center. Keep the center white. Tie
off the end and trim excess yarn once completed.

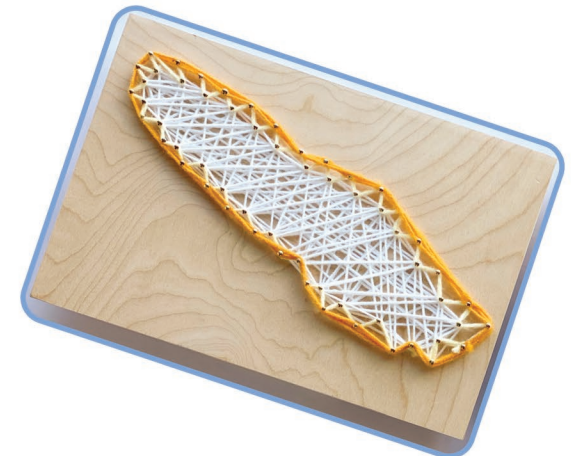


STEP 6

Use a golden yellow yarn to wrap around the
outer nails. Go around the nails two times. Tie off
the end and trim excess yarn once completed.

Pom-Pom tutorial

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

1. Cardstock - 2 sheets per person
2. Scissors
3. Craft glue or hot glue gun
4. Pom-pom balls in various sizes and colors:
 - Cloud: white and various shades of blue
 - Pillar of Fire: amber yellow, lighter yellow and white



STEP 1

Print and cut stencil.



STEP 2

Place and glue pom-poms within the cloud outline.

You're finished!



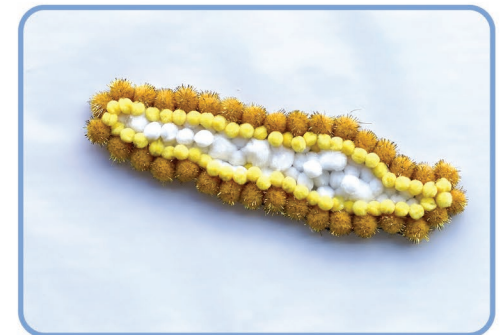

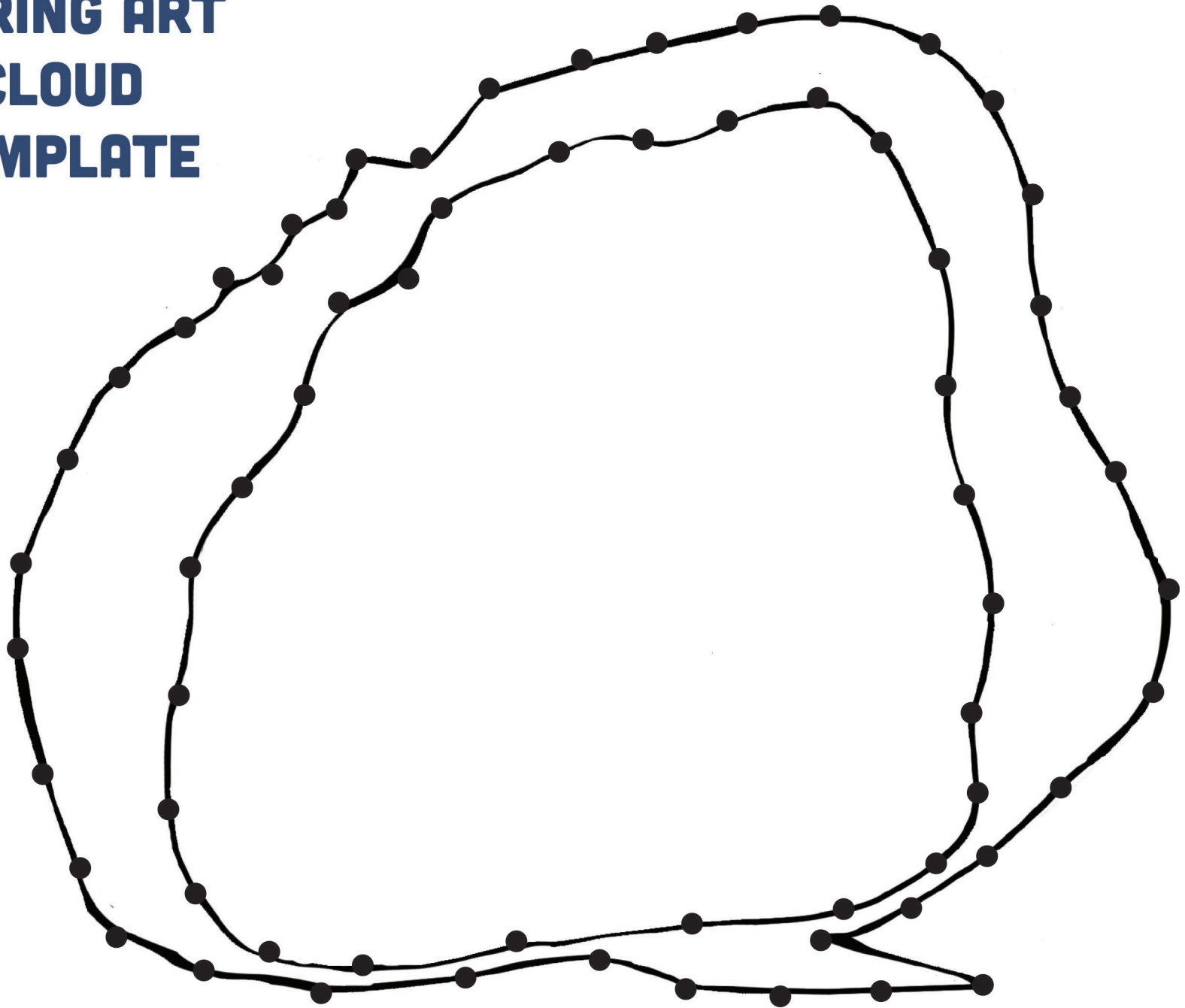
Place and glue pom-poms within the Pillar of Fire outline.



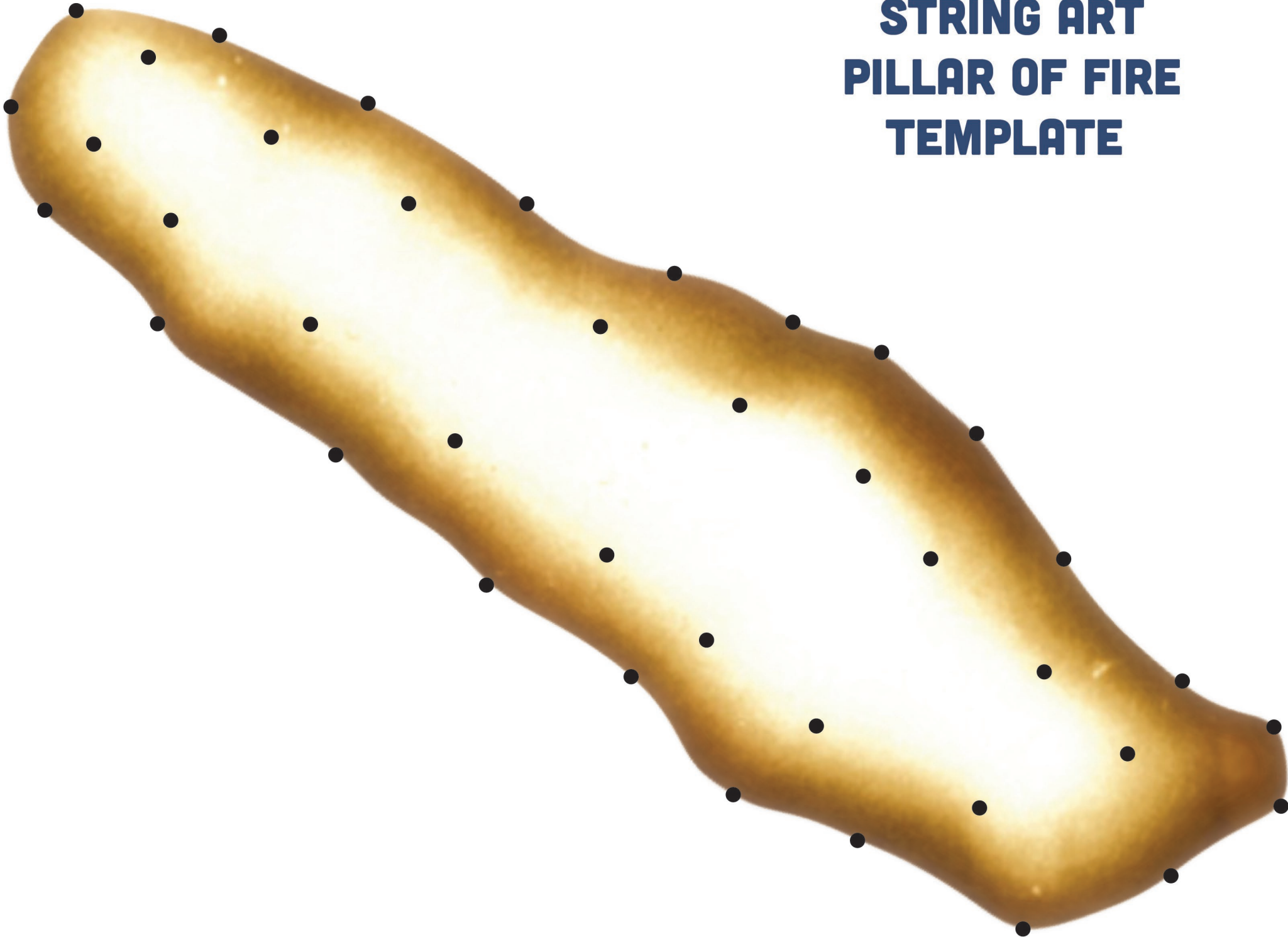

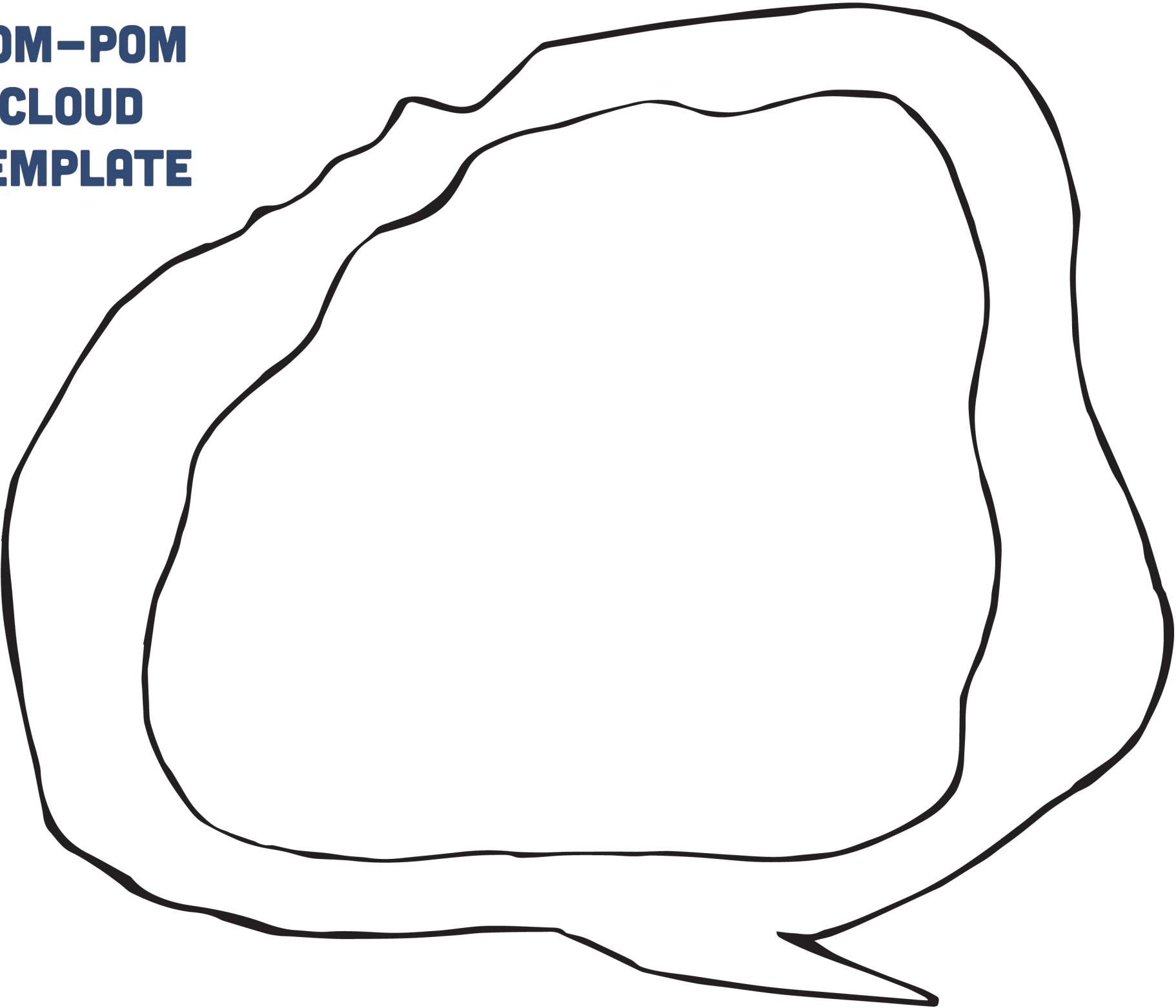

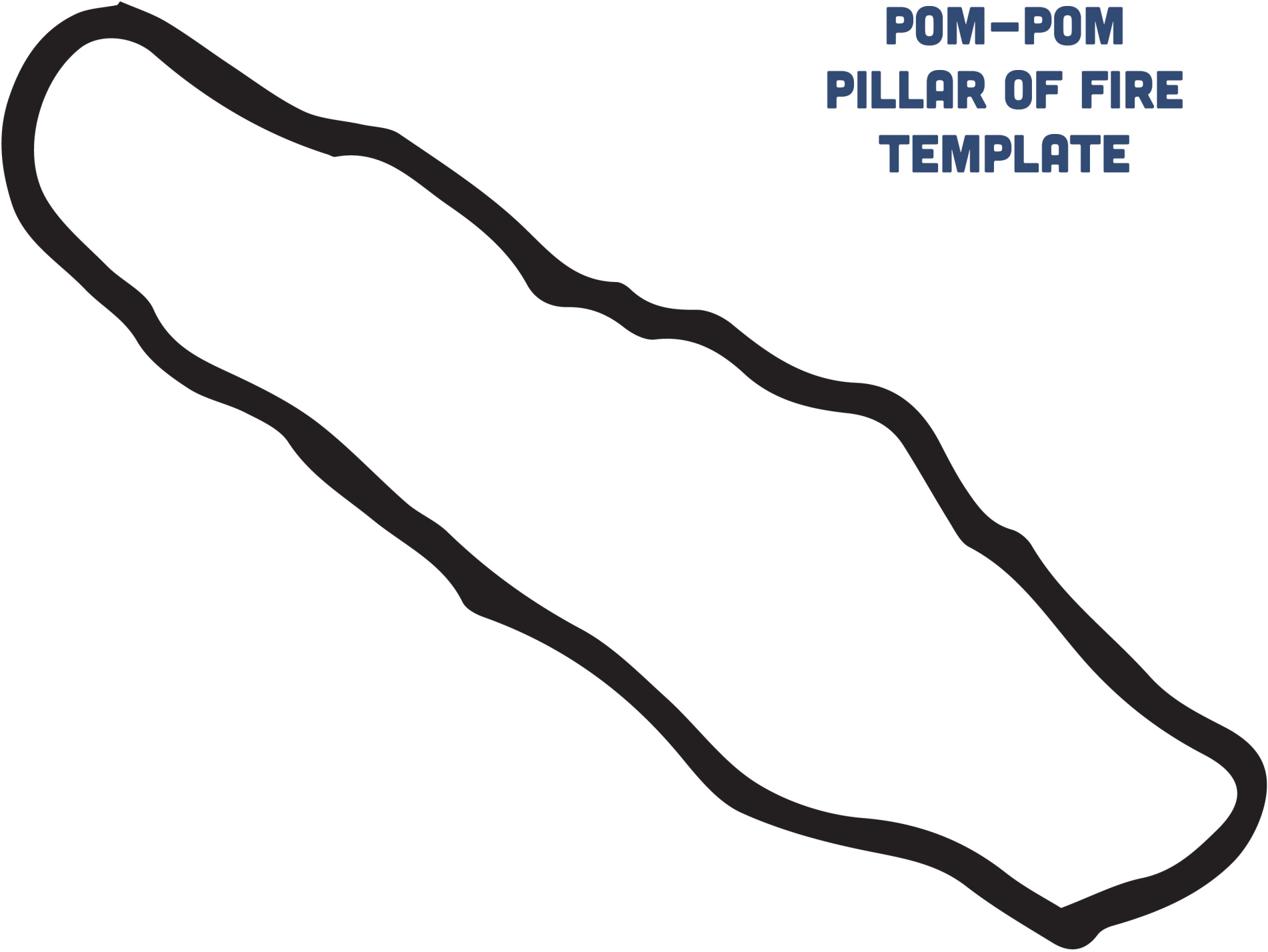
