

- 8"x10"Black Foam Board (if using a large piece, cut to 8"x10")

- (any 7ft 10ft battery operated twinkle lights will work)

 - <u>Glow-In-The-Dark Paint</u>

- Hot Glue GunHot Glue Sticks
- Scissors
- X-ACTO Knife
- Pencil

- Pillar of Fire template cut out
- White Sticker Paper (for printable stickers)
- Step 1: Place Pillar of Fire template under clear plastic sheet. Trace onto plastic with pencil and cut out. Note: Before you start painting, make sure the Pillar of Fire cutout is facing the right direction. You will be painting the underside of Pillar of Fire.
- Step 2: Paint a thin layer of glow-in-the-dark paint on plastic, focusing on the center. Allow to dry.
- Step 3: Paint each section, starting with orange around the border. Paint a strip of yellow around the inner circle. Fill in the center with white paint. Allow each color to dry before going on to next color. (Use a fan for faster dry time.) Tip: Dab paint instead of using long strokes to apply a thicker layer. You can use white to lighten your other colors if needed.
- Step 4: Hot glue twinkle lights to the back of Pillar of Fire, weaving back and forth to cover the whole area. Note: Be careful when gluing lights to Pillar of Fire, as paint is easy to scratch off.
- Step 5: Attach Pillar of Fire to black foam board with hot glue.

Step 6: Add stickers to board.
