CLASS NAME: KNIFE

Project: wooden knife

Start class with a word of prayer. SCRIPTURE

And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son. And the angel of the LORD called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here am I.

And he said, Lay not thine hand upon the lad, neither do thou any thing unto him: for now I know that thou fearest God, seeing thou hast not withheld thy son, thine only son from me.

KNIFE TUTORIAL

MATERIALS NEEDED:

assorted wood

wood glue

epoxy

knife blade (full tang)

metal rods

finish (ex: mineral oil)

gloves

TOOLS NEEDED:

bandsaw

clamps

measuring tape

sand paper

safety glasses

miter saw

round wood file

table saw (optional)

drill

metal drill bit matching the width of the metal rod

CUT LIST:


2 pieces 5" long, 1 3/4" wide, and 1/2" thick

Optional: glue wood pieces together and then
cut to these measurements for a different look.



Cover the edge of the blade with tape before starting the project.



Wear gloves when handling the epoxy.

5.

Mix the epoxy and spread over one side of the tang.

7.

Epoxy the other side of the tang and insert the metal rods through the holes in the tang and wooden piece.

Clamp together, clean excess epoxy, and let dry. Cover the clamps with tape to keep the epoxy from adhering to the clamps.

9.

6.

Place one handle into position, lining up the holes.

8.

Place the other handle into position, lining up the holes with the rods.

10.

Cut off the excess of the metal rods to be flush with the knife.



11.

File and sand the edges of the knife to be flush with the tang.

12.

Apply finish.
