CRAFT CLASS

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CRAFT “The Sword of The King”

AGE: 7-9

ESTIMATED LENGTH: 3 HOURS

NEEDED MATERIALS:

- Bible
- Quote for sword “The Sword Of The King”
- Cardboard base
- Aluminum Foil
- Gold duct tape
- Silver duct tape
- Pearls
- Pearl paint
- Wire
- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Hot Glue Gun

INTRO AND CLASS SUMMARY:

1. Gather Students And Begin In Prayer.
2. Read And Discuss Quotes: Moral parable - This sword represents The Bible. This is not to play with as a toy but to remind us this sword is The Bible.

-SCRIPTURES:

1. Students will try to memorize a Scripture before class and bring their Bibles at class.

2. Bible Verse memorization Hebrew 4:12 – prize (sword Bible book marker)

Class Summary:

The class teaches/helpers pre-cut cardboard paper into the shape of a sword for each student before class (see tutorial pics).

-Go over basic guidelines/rules.

-Show examples/samples and demonstrate.

-Let students begin building and decorating their own swords.

Creating Your Own Sword:

1. First, have the kids cut 3 yards of the chrome duct tape in six inch pieces. (It makes it easier when applying to sword)

2. Next, have them go back to their seats, and instruct them on how to apply it to the sword.

a.) First, rip one of your six inch pieces in half.

b.) Second, rip it in half long ways too, and apply to the point of the sword.

Repeat step until point of the sword is covered.

c.) Third, take two of the six inch pieces and cover the bottom of the blade where it meets the protector.

d.) Then cover the blade completely with just one layer of the duct tape.

e.) Lastly, use the remainder of the duct tape to cover the protector of the sword by ripping the duct tape into strips long ways.

3. Then, have them come back up and measure 14" of the gold duct tape and return to their seats. This will be for the guard. Also have them rip their duct tape into smaller strips in both length and width so it makes it easier for them to apply.

4. Next they will paint their handles with the pearl paint, which you will allot to them once they have reached that point. About ¼ ounce.

5. While the paint is drying, you can ask them Bible trivia questions.
6. Once it's dried they will need to apply their 24" pearl ribbon to the middle of the handle, by hot gluing only the ends.
7. They will need to take their pre-cut 18" strand of wire, and a Dixie cup with 52 of the pearls that you will have to pre-count for them.
 - a.) Have the children to bend the bottom of their wire and strand all the pearls onto the wire.
 - b.) When they're done, you will hot glue it around the handle for them at the ends of the strand of pearls.
8. Finally, the students need to cut out the words THE SWORD OF THE KING and apply them to the blade of their sword with a glue stick.
