

Philadelphian Church Age Study Binder Instructions

Supplies used:

- Printables – Cut out each piece.
- 2 Sheets Black Cardstock
- Adhesive Foam Dots (to attach any stickers you'd like)
- Scissors
- X-ACTO Knife
- Glue/Glue Stick
- Double-sided Tape



Set up your pages

Reminder: Refer to pictures and videos for details and placement.

- 3-hole punch 2 pieces of black cardstock and place in your binder.

Lesson 1:

Paste on left page:

- Title, Messenger, Moon, Philadelphia Means.
- Map:
 - Paste Philadelphia and Great Britain maps together to create a two-sided page. Fold in half to create lift-the-flap.
- Open Door: *see pictures.*
 - Fold Open Door piece in half and paste together to create a two-sided door.
 - Cut along dotted line on back door piece with an X-ACTO knife. Fold tab and insert front door piece and paste.
 - Use adhesive foam dot to paste date printable on outside of door. Paste coordinating printables inside door.
 - Fold Messenger fact card in half to make a book. Paste John Wesley on the outside of book. Paste in door.
- Sanctification:
 - Fold 3 moons printable along fold line and paste to page to create a lift-the-flap.
 - Paste Sanctification printable on outside flap. Paste to page.
- Door to the Sheepfold:
 - Fold Jesus printable along fold line and paste to the sheepfold.
- Write 6th on Wesley printable. Fill in the blanks on page.



Lesson 2:

Paste on right page:

- Paste Foundation printable at the bottom of the page.
- Scriptures:
 - Paste coordinating color tabs on the under-side of each verse.
 - Fold Scripture notes in half.
 - Paste verses on the front of notes to create lift-the-flap.
 - Cut Scriptures along dotted line to create tabs.
- Pillars:
 - For right pillar, cut along dotted lines with X-ACTO knife.
 - Insert tabs of pillar quote into cut lines under pillar to create pull-out quote.
 - Attach pillars to page using adhesive dots.
- Paste Three Names printable, The Reward, Eternal Life, and Mrs. Jesus Christ.
- Fill in the blanks on page.

Answer Key:

Messenger fact card – His mother, Susanna, a consecrated saint.

Philadelphia means – “Love of Brethren.”

Scripture booklet –

- A true Jew is a Holy Ghost-filled Christian.
- Temptation means “tribulation.”
- What’s the Name of God? Jesus
