

# Lesson: God's Honey



- My son, eat thou honey, because it is good; and the honeycomb, which is sweet to thy taste:  
PROVERBS 24:13

- Our theme is The Great Architect. God is the Great Architect and the Great Master Builder.
- But what is an architect? An architect plans how a building will be built by drawing a blueprint. (have example blue print)
- How is God an architect? He thought up and planned all the world, people, animals and said, "Let there be..." and there they were! He created you! He also drew up the blue prints of salvation. He drew up the blue prints – wrote the Bible.
- God, The Great Architect, created the fascinating little bee. Bees are also mentioned in the Bible. Samson found some honey inside a lion carcass.

Here are some bee facts from the Cub Corner:

- 2 sets of wings that beat at 200 beats per second
- 4 legs
- 5 eyes
- Sometimes fly 5 miles or more to find their food
- Can fly 6 miles
- Can fly 15 miles per hour
- Excellent sense of direction
- A beehive is the bee's house. Sometimes bees make their hives in trees (knot hole) or rocks with big cracks, like in a mountain. He lives and works there storing up food (honey). Bees are busy all the time working to make more honey.
- Before bees go to their new home, they swarm. They get really excited and gather together and they fly around. They have lots of energy! Brother Branham said they have a revival!
- Play Quote 1:

"Now, neither have they ever found any better idea for ducks and geese to come south, from the north, than to swarm and then fly their way down. No other way. You see, before they fly down south, or fly from the south back north, they swarm, first. Before they leave their grounds or homes, to a new home, they swarm. Bees does the same thing. They swarm. That's a nature. What is it? They have a revival. They all swarm and get together. You never heard such a noise in your life. And before we can ever leave this habitation, to a new one, we got to swarm in a revival!"

## 63-0115 - Accepting God's Provided Way At The Endtime

- Bees swarm before they go to their new home! We are like bees! We are swarming, having a revival, before we go to our New Home – Heaven!
- What is their food? Honey! Bees make honey! They store their food in their house – a storehouse! We have a Storehouse too, and it is filled with God's Honey – His Word! Brother Branham's messages are like honey to us!
- Did you ever hear of honey in the rock? (talk about David and scrip bag full of honey)
- When we listen to tapes, we are feeding on our honey – the Word! We are a lot like bees!
- Bees swarm and so do we! We are swarming in a revival right now!
- This next quote is on the beehive project.
- Play Quote 2

"No reason at all why this little place here couldn't be a beehive of the power of God, buzzing with the glory of God, flying from everywhere. This little old hole in the wall here, almost, is known throughout the entire world, this little spot you're setting in tonight; because not of William Branham, but because of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, and a Gospel that they've contended for. No, sir, I had nothing to do with it, not at all. It was Him Who did it, and made the place known throughout the world when it was nothing but a little fifteen hundred-dollar structure, or something like that, fixed up here, with no floor in it. But it's God Almighty Who does those things!"

Points:

- God is the Great Architect.
- He loves us and is good to us. He planned and created this beautiful earth for us to live in. He created us. He created all of nature - the bee to "bee" a certain way – make honey, live in a hive, swarm etc.
- Jesus is the Word and the Word is Honey in the Rock to us! We are like bees! We eat stored up food - "God's Honey" and we "swarm" in a revival!
- We should be a beehive of the power of God, buzzing with the glory of God! We are getting ready to leave our old home and go to our new home!

"Everybody feeling good? Oh, that's fine; that's just fine. Well, we hope we can—the Lord will just bless us and we get our hands right in the honey jar now, and go to eating on God's Honey, His Word!"

## Tutorial

### Materials

Ruler



Plastic Knife



Small pail of water



Air dry clay

Water based 5 lb container  
(can be found at most craft stores or online)

Scissors



Wax paper



Toothpicks



Baking scale



Hot glue gun



Cake pop stick

Bee stickers








1. Grab a chunk of your clay and use your scale to measure out 6.5 oz of clay.



2. Then place your clay on a square piece of wax paper.




3. Make your hands slightly damp with water and knead your clay to make it softer and more pliable.



4. Pull off a small chunk of clay from what you measured and use your hands to roll it out to be 15 inches long. Make sure it doesn't get too thin or it will break apart!




5. Use your knife to cut small indents or scoring marks along the rolled out piece of clay.




6. Dip two of your fingertips in the cup of water and gently rub over the rolled out piece of clay.



7. Flip over your rolled out piece of clay and repeat steps 5-6.



8. Use another piece of wax paper to put your rolled out piece of clay on.



9. Begin coiling your piece of clay starting from the center and working your way out in circular fashion until you reach the end.



10. Dip your fingertips in the cup of water and gently press and rub your now circular piece of clay to make it stick and seal together.



11. Repeat steps 1-7 to make another 15 inch piece of clay.



12. Begin wrapping your new strand of clay along the top of the outer edge of the flat circular piece of clay. Make sure your scoring marks lay on the clay to help it stick together.




13. Once you have wrapped one full circle around the edge, take your knife and make more scoring marks along the top.



14. Use your fingertips to lightly rub and apply more water.



15. Continue wrapping your long strand of clay directly on top of the circular edge you just made while making sure to line up your scoring marks.



16. Once you have made another complete circle, use your knife to make more scoring marks and apply more water.





17. Continue on until your strand of clay is all used up.



18. Repeat steps 1-7 to make another 15-inch piece of clay



19. Before applying your third strand, make sure that the top outer edge of your last strand has been properly scored and dampened with your fingertips



20. Begin adding your third strand to your beehive. As you add, gradually start making your next circle smaller than the one below it so that the higher you build it up, it will give a cone effect.



21. Make sure to stop every full circle to score and dampen the top of the beehive. Also, rub the inner and outer walls of the beehive with wet fingertips after you finish a strand



22. Repeat steps 1-7, except roll out your piece of clay to be 12 inches instead of 15 inches



23. Add your fourth strand as you did before, wrapping to make a cone shape. Don't forget to score and dampen every layer, and rub the walls with wet fingertips



24. Repeat steps 1-7, and make another 12-inch strand



25. Add your fifth strand as you did before, wrapping to make a cone shape. Score and dampen every layer, and rub the walls with wet fingertips



26. Repeat steps 1-7, only roll out your piece of clay to be 8 inches instead of 15-inches



27. Add your sixth strand as you did the others. Once this piece is added to your beehive, there should only be a very small opening left at the top.



28. Place the cake pop stick about half way down on the back of one of your quotes. Use your hot glue gun to apply glue all over the back of the quote, making sure to go over the cake pop stick as well




29. Take your other printout quote and apply the back of it to the glue and the other quote. Use your fingers to press the two quotes together until the hot glue has dried



30. Take three of your foam bee stickers and peel off the sticker backing. Apply a toothpick to the sticky back and add hot glue to secure it.




31. Use your scissors to trim the edges of the paper so that it doesn't overlap.



32. Use your X-ACTO knife to cut a small door opening in your beehive about half way down on one side.





Place the cake pop stick with your beehive quote in the small opening at the top of your beehive. Slightly unwrap the top strand of your beehive and wrap it tighter around

Last, poke in your toothpicks with bee stickers around the outside of your beehive.

You are finished!!!
